### SGPS Opportunity Class

Opportunity classes are for high potential and gifted students in Years 5 and 6. Students attend the opportunity classes full-time. There are 57 schools located in metropolitan Sydney and 31 schools located in rural or regional centres. To access this class • students must sit a placement test. Students who gain a position in the opportunity class (OC) are offered the position for a two year period. They enrol in the class in Year 5 and continue with their OC studies in Year 6. Fifteen new students are accepted each year, with fifteen students continuing in Year 6 (for a total of 30 students in the class).
