We have had another busy week at South Grafton Public School. We hope all of our school community have stayed safe with minimal impact from the devastating fires in the Clarence Valley.



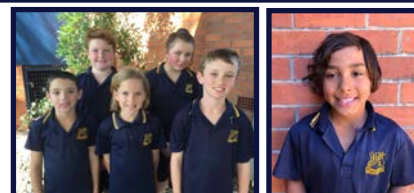
